

Search for Treasures – Art Exhibition by Ianthi Aggelioglou

The third solo exhibition of visual artist **Ianthi Aggelioglou**, titled **“Search for Treasures”**, opens at the **Auberge de France**, in the Medieval City of Rhodes, on **Thursday 16 October 2025** at 19:00 and runs until 31 October 2025.

The exhibition presents three series of works from 2017–2025, mainly wall-based fabric compositions alongside small-scale works on paper. It also includes an interactive component, inviting visitors to create their own fabric assemblages with prepared materials.

Curated by art historian **Poly Chatzimarkou**, the exhibition highlights Aggelioglou’s unique language of “organic shapes and chromatic compositions – a biomorphic alphabet and, at the same time, a bodily writing, where forms function as codes of an introspective language, and the images are not simply ‘read’ but experienced tactilely and emotionally.”

Aggelioglou’s visual universe thrives in the dialogue between abstraction and materiality, between memory fragments and contemporary textile practices, producing works that resemble “breaths of the world – islands of form that allow reality to circulate and pulsate, reminding us that art is the experience of living matter.”
